## STATEMENT

On September 29, 2014, Appellant was arrested by the Greenville County Sheriff Department for Armed Robbery (2014-GS-23-10896), and Possession of A Weapon (2014-GS-23-10897), both crimes are not a True Bill.

Upon Appellant Attorney Dorothy Manigault advice he pled guilty to those charges on March 5, 2015 and was sentenced to Fifteen years by the Honorable R. Scott Sprouse. On May 20, 2015, Appellant filed his post-conviction relief ("PCR") application on ineffective assistance of counsel and violation of the plea deal.

On November 6, 2018, Appellant filed his second post-conviction relief application based on After-Discovered evidence. Appellant never was indicted by a Grand Jury for the September 29, 2014 crimes in which he pled guilty to. Respondent claims that Appellant second PCR is successive however, Appellant was not aware of both crimes have yet to be presented to a Grand Jury until after the filing of his original PCR.

## ARGUMENT

Appellant was not indicted for the September 29, 2014  
Crimes. State Constitution requires a person be indicted by  
the grand jury before standing trial for a crime. Appellant  
was not aware that he wasn't indicted therefore, he  
couldn't raise it in his first PCR.



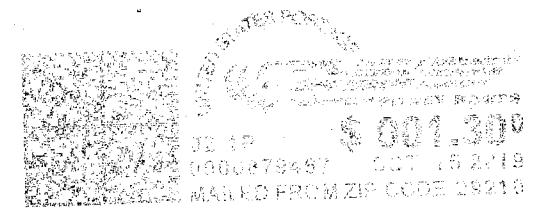
