This appeal was dismissed due to Appellant's failure to provide proof that he served the Record on Appeal. Appellant subsequently filed a petition for rehearing. On July 18, 2012, this Court issued an order allowing Appellant an additional thirty days to prepare and serve the Record on Appeal and stating that Appellant's petition for rehearing would be considered upon receipt of Appellant's proof of service for the Record on Appeal or within thirty days. In August 2012, Appellant filed a letter, explaining he is unable to comply with the Court's order "due to the fact that the South Carolina Department of Corrections' Lee Correctional Institution lost some of his property/belongings which included his case file." Appellant requested that the Court provide him "with copies of the complete case file" and appoint counsel. The Court construed all of Appellant's filings together as a petition for rehearing and because Appellant failed to cure the deficiency that resulted in the dismissal of his appeal, the petition was denied on January 15, 2013. Appellant now moves to appeal to the Supreme Court of South Carolina.
