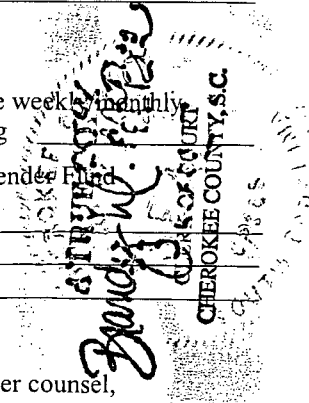

BURGLARY FIRST DEGREE (DWELLING)
