Per telephone conversation with Jared Brown, at Judge Marvin Dukes' office, I am writing this letter to show and to clarify the appeal from the Magistrate Court on the two referenced cases both came from the same citations at the Magistrate Court. (Your original letter already explained that you have talked to Stephanie Garst at the Magistrate Court and you should be clear on all the issues.) Your record can show that the 2018 case was denied or affirmed by Judge Dukes and had already been sent to the S.C. Court of Appeals as Appellate Case No. 2018-002225. As you can recall the court of appeals put the appeal case in abeyance, and remanded the case to the Magistrate Court and for the limited purpose of my motion for new trial base on after discovered evidence of the Brady material which I claim to be the correct location of the accident. which evidence was hidden by the Highway officer Mazzone.

As shown in the Magistrate Order, my motion was denied and I am not appealing that denial to the Circuit Court so I can combine the referenced two cases in the same appeal case.

The Magistrate has not filed a Return on my second appeal. They need to be informed that they are required to do so because I have the right to appeal Magistrate Fuentes denial to the court of appeals.

Therefore, please ask the Magistrate Court to file a Return on its latest order as attached and schedule a hearing as soon as possible.

As you may know the Court of Appeals is asking the reason of the delay and I am explaining here with a copy to the court of appeals.

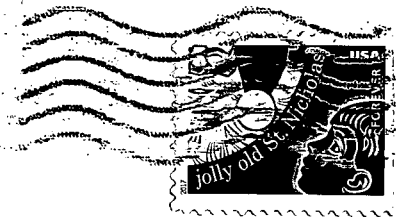
