ORDER

By order dated May 31, 2019, this Court declined to entertain various motions and petitions filed by petitioner under Rule 245 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules. This order, however, did not address a document entitled "motion to prevent inordinate delay" which alleged the appeal in Appellate Case Number 2016-001553 was being unnecessarily delayed.
