**Petition for Extension of Time to File the Final Brief and Record on Appeal**





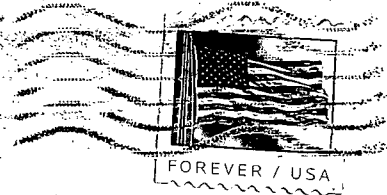
