ORDER

Respondent South Carolina Department of Employment and Workforce's motion to strike the record on appeal is granted. Within thirty days of this order, Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal that complies with Rule 210 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR).

Pursuant to Rule 210, SCACR, the amended record shall include all documents listed in both parties' designations of matter, and the amended record shall not include any matter that was not presented to the administrative law court. Further, the amended record shall not include any handwritten notes or markings that did not appear on the documents presented to the administrative law court. Finally, the amended record must contain consecutive page numbers at the bottom of each page, beginning with the index.
