Dear Mr. Williams:

This responds to your documents entitled "Judicial Notice to courts. ..Objection to October 17, 2019 order in part . . . /objection to the State", "Objection to State," and "Rule 269 SCACR Petition to Dismiss States Frivolous Fraudulent writ of certiorari/Appeal review Request . . . Rule 269 SCACR." These documents, which were received today, have been construed as motions.

No action will be taken on these motions for two reasons. First, you have failed to provide an affidavit or certificate of service showing that a copy of these documents have been served on the counsel for the State as required by Rule 240(c)(1) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.

Second, on October 21, 2019, the Court of Appeals sent the remittitur in the underlying appeal.<sup>1</sup> Because the sending of the remittitur ended appellate jurisdiction over this case, *Wise v. S.C. Dept. of Corr.*, 372 S.C. 173, 642 S.E.2d
