The defendant, William Holmes, did on or about March 7, 2015, in Charleston County, South Carolina, with knowledge that he was within a one half mile radius of the grounds of Military Magnet High School, a public or private elementary, middle or secondary school; a public playground or park; a public vocational or trade school or technical educational center; or a public or private college or university, distribute, sell, manufacture, or unlawfully possess with intent to distribute Crack Cocaine, a controlled substance under provisions of Section 44-53-110, et seq., South Carolina Code of Laws (1976, as amended). All in violation of 44-53-0445(A), South Carolina Code of Laws (1976, as amended).

Against the peace and dignity of the State, and contrary to the statute in such case made and provided.



All in violation of 44-53-0375(B)(1) of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.


