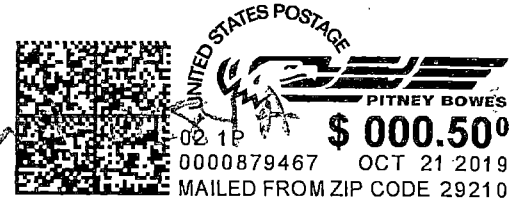

of conviction, within that time I only got one plea deal from Mr. George H Debusk with 15 years I do not believe Attorney Barbara Wilso pratt ever fought to get me any lower pleas on my behalf and I was told that if I went to trial I would receive more than the 15 years being offered so to my knowledge signing the plea was my best chance at getting 10 years which is why I sign the plea. I was 20 years old the day of my arrest still a young boy who got caught in the wrong situation. I would like to say within those three years I have lost my fiance and two daughters do to death and I am now a single father and I will like to give some time back not only for me but for my son so I can be a father and serve my community. Im sorry to all families involved but I pray they will forgive me as well as the court and give me fair counsil and judgement due to the lack of consistence of the Roll In which I played in the matter thanks in advance for you guys help.
