MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION  
TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Brandon James Littell respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until December 4, 2019**, in which to file the Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The Petition for Writ of Certiorari and Appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.

2. Counsel for Brandon James Littell respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. On October 31, 2019, counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and record on appeal in The State v. Alonza King Gibson with the Court of Appeals. On October 29, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals in The State v. George Holmes with the Supreme Court. On October 25, 2019, counsel filed a brief of petitioner in The State v. Felix Kotowski with the Supreme Court. On October 18, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Brian Edward Norris v. The State with the Supreme Court. On October 15, 2019, counsel had an oral argument in The State v. Terrell Artieth Smith before the Supreme Court. On October 4, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Mildred Montgomery v. The State with the Supreme Court. On October 1, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Otis Maurice Robinson v. The State with the Supreme Court. On September 27, 2019, counsel filed a petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in Larry Brayboy v. The State with the Supreme Court. From September 23, 2019 through September 25, 2019, counsel attended the Annual Public Defender Conference in Myrtle Beach. On September 18, 2019, counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in The State v. Keunte Cobbs with the Court of Appeals. On September 12, 2019, counsel filed a petition for rehearing in The State v. George Holmes with the Court of Appeals. On August 30, 2019, counsel filed the brief of respondent in The State v. Archie More Hardin with the Supreme Court.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request as shown by signature below.
