ORDER

Petitioner has filed a motion, which this court construes as a request for the court to recall the remittitur and reinstate the appeal. A remittitur cannot be recalled except upon "a very strong showing . . . that remittitur was sent down through some mistake or inadvertence on the part of this Court or its officer." *State v. Keels*, 39 S.C. 553, 17 S.E. 802 (1893). Petitioner has failed to make such a showing. The remittitur was properly sent, and this Court no longer has jurisdiction over the case. Petitioner's motion, therefore, is denied.
