

I, Caros Pupo, of Myrtle Beach, in Horry County, South Carolina, declare the following to be true:



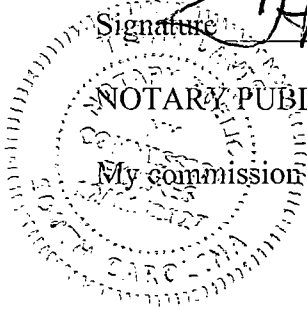



I, Larry W. Richardson, of Myrtle Beach, in Horry County, South Carolina, declare the following to be true:

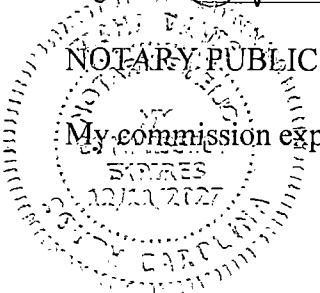

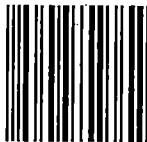
