Dear Ms. Allen

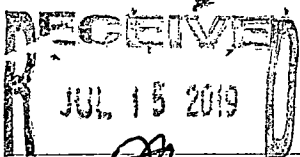

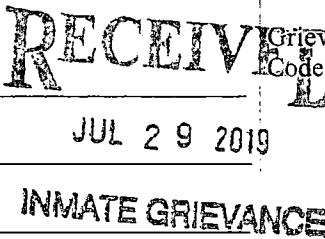

INMATE'S REASON FOR APPEAL (state specific dissatisfaction): *There's several discrepancies with in the warden's decision and reason. Firstly, my QMHP Ms. Johnson (see Ms. Johnson notes) and I was informed by CAPTAIN ANDREWS and LT. JONES that AWO Ms. Gause did removed that 809 charge on 4/11/19. Secondly, its evident that all my sanctions and restrictions are active because on 4/27/19 I had a visit and continue to use all my privileges well after my DHD hearing and before 8/9/19 which Im thankful for. Finally, Evans Corr. Inst. Administrators have actual notice of DE. McMillan unethical behavior and his continuance to antagonize, threaten, intimidate and falsely submit fabricated threatening to inflict charges on inmates as well, but mainly I. McMillan is upset that I was documenting and submitting his unethical behavior to my Unit Lt. Moutrie, QMHP Ms. Johnson, McFadden, Major West and AWO Gause prior to me receiving a false charge. hence reason for AWO Gause to lift Grievant Signature Jamin Mazyck Date 7/13/19 my sanctions. RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL'S DECISION AND REASON:

The documentation provided indicates that the evidence presented was sufficient to support the conviction of Threatening to Inflict Harm on an Employee and/or Members of the Public (809), case #27, Level 2 Offense, held on April 11, 2019. The conviction was consistent with SCDC Policy OP-22.14, Inmate Disciplinary System, dated February 2, 2015. The sanction(s) imposed, which included the loss of -6- days accrued good time, were appropriate for the rules violation(s). There was no reason found to warrant a reversal of the Disciplinary Hearing Officer's decision. A review of your appeal revealed that you received forty-eight (48) hour notice prior to the hearing. You were afforded due process rights, as required, and the offense was classified and heard in a timely manner.

Therefore, your grievance is denied.

You may appeal this decision under the Administrative Procedures Act to the Administrative Law Court. In order to appeal, you must fill out the attached Notice of Appeal Form and submit it as instructed on the form within 30 days of receipt.

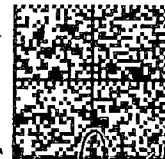
