Dear Mr. Plum and Ms. Ahearn:

Upon reviewing your notice of appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your appeal will be dismissed:

- The accompanying proof of service is not in compliance with the SCACR. Your proof of service should be substantially in the format shown by Form 7 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- The caption/title of the notice of appeal does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the notice of appeal should be substantially in the format shown by Form 1 in Appendix C to part II of the SCACR.
- You must file an amended notice of appeal which complies with Rule 203, SCACR, specifically naming the orders being appealed, stating the date(s) on which they were received, and including the attorney information regarding counsel for the respondent.

- You must provide proof that you have filed the notice of appeal with the trial court clerk pursuant to Rule 203(d)(1)(B), SCACR.
