MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Olandio Workman with the Court of Appeals on September 27, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Jose Reyes Reyes v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on September 20, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari to the Court of Appeals and accompanying appendix in the case of Aaron Young, Sr. v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on September 20, 2019.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.

5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.




