MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT  
AND DESIGNATION OF MATTER

Counsel for Robert Xavier Geter respectfully requests an extension of **thirty (30) days, until December 18, 2019**, in which to file the Initial Brief of Appellant and Designation of Matter in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Robert Xavier Geter respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

3. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. John M. Ghent, Jr., to the Supreme Court from this Court on November 12, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Anthony Raynard Randall with this Court on November 8, 2019. Counsel was co-counsel to Adam Sinclair Ruffin, when they filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. William D. Pennington with this Court on November 4, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of James A. Gardner v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 28, 2019. Counsel also had an oral argument before this Court on October 22, 2019 in State v. Deshandon Franks in Clemson, South Carolina. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Dashaun Livaughn Simmons with this Court on October 21, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jakeivan A. Pulley v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 18, 2019. Counsel filed the two issue petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of The State v. Ahshaad Mykiel Owens with the Supreme Court on October 14, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. William C. (Billy) Sellers with this Court on October 2, 2019. Counsel presented the Case Law Update PowerPoint presentation at the annual Public Defender Conference, which was held in Myrtle Beach, South Carolina, on September 23-25, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Joseph Michael Manners v. The State with the Supreme Court on September 20, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Isaiah Gadson, Jr., with this Court on


on September 13, 2019. **Counsel has extensive administrative duties as the Chief Appellate Defender, including administrative and Appellate Project oversight, and training four less experienced appellate defenders and reviewing all their filings in advance.**

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay. Counsel intends to continue to work on the cases with more than three extensions first so that the caseload will hopefully become more manageable in the near future, and less extensions will need to be requested.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request shown by signature below.
