COUNT ONE

**MURDER**

That ANTHONY KWAME MAYS did in Greenville County, on or about the 2nd day of April, 2017, unlawfully and with malice aforethought kill AZAVEON COOK by means of shooting him with a handgun, causing him to die as a proximate result thereof. This is in violation of §16-3-10 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

COUNT TWO

**ATTEMPTED MURDER**

That ANTHONY KWAME MAYS did in Greenville County, on or about the 2nd day of April 2017, unlawfully, with malice aforethought and with the intent to kill, attempt to kill JAIKARIO POOLE. This is in violation of § 16-3-29 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.

COUNT THREE

**ASSAULT AND BATTERY BY MOB 1<sup>ST</sup> DEGREE**

That ANTHONY KWAME MAYS did in Greenville County on or about the 2nd day of April, 2017, willfully and unlawfully participate as part of a mob who inflicted an act of violence upon AZAVEON COOK resulting in his death. This is in violation of §16-03-0210 of the South Carolina Code of Laws (1976) as amended.


COUNT FOUR

**ASSAULT AND BATTERY BY MOB 2<sup>ND</sup> DEGREE**
