

**RULE 203(B) EXPLANATION**

Pursuant to Rule 203(B)(iv), the issue to be raised on appeal is whether the trial court abused its discretion when it imposed the sentence of Poss. of 28g (1 oz) or less of marijuana or 10g - 2nd or sub. Offense on indictment no: 2019-GS-46-03102 and Domestic Violence, 1st degree on indictment no: 2019-GS-46-03101, Throwing of bodily fluids by prisoner, detainee on state corrections or local law enforcement officer, corrections employee, or visitor on indictment no: 2019-GS-46-03296 and Assault, beat, or wound police officer serving process or while resisting arrest on indictment no: 2019-GS-46-03295. Appellant received Time Served on indictment 2019-GS-46-03102 and (8) eight years concurrent; credit for time served (159) one hundred fifty nine days on indictment 2019-GS-46-03101, (1) one year concurrent to 19-03295; credit for time served (159) one hundred fifty nine days on indictment no: 2019-GS-46-03296 and (1) one year concurrent on indictment no: 2019-GS-46-03295.

The undersigned does not have a good faith basis to believe that this issue is properly before the Court of Appeals, and the undersigned did not object to the sentence or file a motion to reconsider the sentence. Nevertheless, the undersigned consulted with the Appellant about his right to appeal, and after consultation, the undersigned has filed the instant appeal at the request of the Appellant because the Sixth Amendment requires counsel to follow the Appellant's request. *See Frazer v. South Carolina*, 430 F.3d 696, 705 (4<sup>th</sup> Cir. 2005) ("A defendant has a right to pursue a direct appeal, even if frivolous, which counsel must assist as 'an active advocate on behalf of his client.'") (quoting *Anders v. California*, 386 U.S. 738, 744 (1967)).
