
COUNT FOUR

At a Court of General Sessions, convened on December 1, 2016 the Grand Jurors of SUMTER County present upon their oath:

COUNT ONE
ARMED ROBBERY

That on or about August 21, 2016, in Sumter County, South Carolina, the Defendant, Brandon Jamal McFadden, at 226 Broad Street, Sumter, South Carolina, by use of force, threats or intimidation and while armed with a deadly weapon, or while alleging, either by action or words, he was armed while using a representation of a deadly weapon or other object which a person present during the commission of the robbery reasonably believed to be a deadly weapon, did take and carry away goods and/or monies from the person or immediate presence of Young's Food Store #608 with the intent to permanently deprive the victim of possession thereof, in violation of Section 16-11-330(A) of the South Carolina Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT TWO
POSSESSION OF A WEAPON DURING THE COMMISSION
OF A VIOLENT CRIME

That Brandon Jamal McFadden did in Sumter County, on or about August 21, 2016, possess a firearm, or visibly display what appeared to be a firearm, or visibly displayed a knife, during the commission or attempted commission of a violent crime, in violation of Section 16-23-0490, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.

COUNT THREE
UNLAWFUL CARRYING OF PISTOL

That Brandon Jamal McFadden did in Sumter County on or about August 21, 2016, carry about the person a pistol, such carrying not being authorized by law, in violation of Section 16-23-0020, S. C. Code of Laws, 1976, as amended.




