Dear Ms. Tucker:

Upon reviewing your Notice of Appeal, the following deficiencies have been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and these deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or this appeal will be dismissed:

- Although you have included Mr. Curtis Tucker, pro se appellant, in the signature block of your notice of appeal, Mr. Tucker has not signed the notice of appeal himself. Therefore, Mr. Tucker is not considered an appellant in this appeal. Unless you are an attorney licensed to practice law in this state, you can only represent yourself in this appeal.
- You will need to provide an amended notice of appeal that conforms strictly with Rules 203 and 267, SCACR.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption should contain the name of the appellate court where the document is to be filed (i.e. The Court of Appeals) and the title of the case should read as follows:


