Dear Ms. Tucker:

Upon reviewing your emergency motion, the following deficiency has been noted under the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), and this deficiency must be corrected within ten (10) days of the date of this letter or your motion will not be considered:

- Although you have included Mr. Curtis Tucker, pro se appellant, as the movant of the motion, Mr. Tucker has not signed the motion himself. Therefore, Mr. Tucker is not considered an appellant in this appeal and cannot file a motion. Unless you are an attorney licensed to practice law in this state, you can only represent yourself in this appeal.
- The caption/title does not comply with Rule 267(a), SCACR. Specifically, the caption should contain the name of the appellate court where the document is to be filed (i.e. The Court of Appeals) and the title of the case should read as follows:

v.

Curtis R. Tucker; Ashley Tucker; SC Housing Corp., acting through South Carolina State Housing Finance and Development Authority's South Carolina Homeownership and Employment Lending Program; and South Carolina Federal Credit Union, Defendants,

Of whom Ashley Tucker is the Appellant.
