Re: James Kincannon v. Ashely Griffith, Appellate Case No. 2019-001501

Ladies and Gentlemen:

I recently received a letter from the Clerk's Office of the South Carolina Court of Appeals dated November 14, 2019 relating to the status of the transcript in the above case suggesting that the court reporter has missed her deadline for preparing the transcript. There appears to be a discrepancy regarding the South Carolina Court of Appeals' understanding of the deadline for preparation of the transcript and the court reporter's understanding of the deadline—the court reporter has represented to the undersigned that the deadline for preparing the transcript is December 15, 2019 rather than whatever date the South Carolina Court of Appeals believes to be the deadline. I am enclosing a copy of two email communications I received from the court reporter indicating her belief that the deadline for preparation of the transcript is December 15.

I am no expert on calculation of dates for transcript preparation deadlines, and I would hope that the South Carolina Office of Court Administration and/or the South Carolina Court of Appeals would treat this letter as a request for extension of the transcript deadline, if necessary, to December 15, 2019 to coincide with what the court reporter apparently believes to be her deadline.

I have received your letter dated September 23, 2019, wherein you request the Transcript of Record in the case of Kincannon vs. Griffith. Upon review of my notes, I estimate the transcript will be approximately 14 pages long for an estimated cost of \$66.50 which includes postage and handling. An electronic copy can also be furnished with any official transcript order for an additional \$40.00, which would total \$106.50. I will waive the electronic copy fee and, of course, postage and handling if you would like only an electronic copy, making the total \$59.50.

If the transcript is smaller than estimated, I will certainly refund your money. Likewise, if it is larger than my estimation, I will either call or write you to let you know of the balance owed before providing you with the transcript.

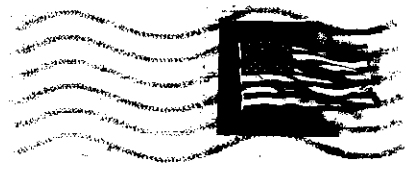
It is necessary that I receive payment before producing the transcript in the form of a cashier's check, money order, or law firm check made payable to Bethanie Creppon. I cannot accept a personal check from you. Upon receipt of the funds, I will place your transcript in line for production. By statute, I am allowed 60 days to complete the transcript. If a longer period is needed, I will request an extension and you will be informed by Court Administration.
