
**MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE RETURN TO THE SOUTH  
CAROLINA DEPARTMENT OF REVENUE'S AMICUS BRIEF**

Pursuant to Rule 240 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules, Intervenor/Respondent Central Midlands Regional Transit Authority ("CMRTA") moves this Court for an order granting an extension of time for CMRTA to serve and file its Return to the South Carolina Department of Revenue's Amicus Brief in the above-captioned action.
