Now comes the defendant and hereby requests that the Honorable Court charge the jury as follows:

SELF DEFENSE

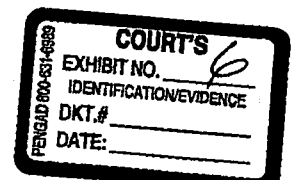
The defendant, DONTARIOUS WRIGHT, has raised the defense of self-defense.

The State of South Carolina has the burden of disproving self-defense beyond a reasonable doubt.

I charge you that DONTARIOUS WRIGHT is presumed innocent and never has to prove himself innocent.

In the case of **Self-Defense**, the State must prove to you that DONTARIOUS WRIGHT did, in fact, not act in self-defense and the State of South Carolina must prove this to you beyond a reasonable doubt.

I charge you that a person in South Carolina is justified in using force which is intended or likely to cause death or great bodily harm if he reasonably believes that such force is necessary to prevent death or great bodily injury to himself or a third person.



Self-defense is a complete defense.

If you have a reasonable doubt as to DONTARIOUS WRIGHT's guilt after considering all the evidence including the evidence of self-defense, then you must find him not guilty.

On the other hand, if you have no reasonable doubt of DONTARIOUS WRIGHT's guilt after considering all the evidence including the evidence of self-defense then you must find him guilty.

I further charge you that in making your determination as to whether the State of South Carolina has completely disproved that DONTARIOUS WRIGHT acted in self defense and completely disproved this beyond a reasonable doubt you may consider the following laws on self defense and defense of others.

Remember, I charge you that the defendant never has the burden of proof in a criminal case. THEREFORE:

First, DONTARIOUS WRIGHT must be without fault in bringing on the difficulty.

Second, DONTARIOUS WRIGHT was actually in imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury

or

He actually believed he was in imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury.

If DONTARIOUS WRIGHT was actually in imminent danger, it must be shown that the circumstances would have warranted a person of ordinary firmness and courage to strike the fatal blow to prevent death or serious bodily injury.

If DONTARIOUS WRIGHT believed he was in imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury, it must be shown that a reasonably prudent person of ordinary firmness and courage would have had the same belief.

In deciding whether DONTARIOUS WRIGHT actually was, or believed he was, in imminent danger of death or serious bodily injury, you should consider all the facts and circumstances surrounding the event.

DONTARIOUS WRIGHT does not have to show that he was actually in danger.

It is enough if he believed he was in imminent danger and a reasonably prudent person of ordinary firmness and courage would have had the same belief.

The defendant, DONTARIOUS WRIGHT, has the right to act on appearances even though his beliefs may have been mistaken.

It is for you to decide whether his fear of immediate danger of death or serious bodily injury was reasonable and would have been felt by an ordinary person in the same situation.

I further charge you that:

If DONTARIOUS WRIGHT is justified in defending himself and in firing the first shot or leveling the first blow, then HE is also justified in continuing to shoot or continuing to inflict blows until it is apparent that the danger of death or serious bodily injury has completely ended.

Additionally, once his right to fire or respond with deadly force in self-defense arises, he is not required to wait until his adversary is on equal terms or until his adversary has fired or aimed his weapon or leveled a blow upon him.

The law of self-defense in South Carolina does not require that any defendant wait until his assailant gets the drop on him and all defendants have the right to act under the law of self-preservation and prevent the assailant from getting the drop on him.

Prior difficulties

Evidence of prior difficulties between the defendant and the victim may be considered in deciding whether a threat existed, whether the defendant had a reason to believe a threat existed, and how serious that threat was.

Size and age

The relative sizes, ages, and weights of the defendant and the victim may be considered in deciding the apparent or actual need for force in self-defense and the amount of force needed.

Threats by the victim

Threats made by the victim may be considered in determining whether the defendant actually was, or believed he was, in imminent danger.

No other way to avoid danger

The final element of self-defense is that the defendant had no other probable way to avoid the danger of death or serious bodily injury than to act as the defendant did in this particular instance.

I further instruct you that the defendant had no duty to retreat if, by doing so, the danger of being killed or suffering serious bodily injury would increase.

Words accompanied by hostile acts

Words accompanied by hostile acts may, depending on the circumstances, establish self-defense.

A person cannot be required to make an exact calculation as to the degree or amount of force which may be needed to avoid death or serious bodily harm. Therefore, in self-defense, the defendant, DONTARIOUS WRIGHT, has the right to use the force needed to avoid death or serious bodily harm. The force used in self-defense does not have to be limited to the degree or amount of force used by the victim. The defendant has the right to use so much force as appeared to


be necessary for complete self-protection, and which a person of ordinary reason and firmness would have believed to be needed to prevent death or serious bodily harm.

I charge you again

DONTARIOUS WRIGHT is presumed innocent and never has to prove himself innocent.

The State of South Carolina has the burden of disproving self-defense beyond a reasonable doubt. In other words, proving to you beyond a reasonable doubt that this defendant, DONTARIOUS WRIGHT, did not act in self-defense.






