I represent the Respondent/Appellant in the above matter. Ron Stanley represents Appellants/Respondents, Otis Morris, Jr. and Pro Bowl Motors, Inc., and Leland Greeley represents Appellants/Respondents, Gerald Scott Dixon, Michael Tyrone Moore, and Dixon's Automotive, LLC.

I received your letter dated November 22, 2019. As reflected in your letter, both the Record on Appeal and an Appendix to the Record on Appeal have now been filed. Final briefs are due by December 11, 2019. Unfortunately, the record is still not complete.

Mr. Greeley originally designated Defendants' Exhibits 2, 3, 4, and 5 in paragraph 6 of his Designation of Matter to be Included in the Record on Appeal. I prefaced my designation of matter with, "In addition to those matters proposed to be included in the Record on Appeal by Appellants/Respondents, Respondent/Appellant also proposes that the following be included . . .". Thus, both of us designated Defendants' Exhibits 2, 3, 4, and 5 be included in the record on appeal. Unfortunately, those exhibits are not included in the Record on Appeal or in the Appendix to the Record on Appeal.

In addition to the above, while I was attempting to conform my initial briefs to final form last week, I recognized that although I had referred to Vol. II, page 133 of the Transcript on page 4 of my Initial Brief Of Respondent/Appellant and Plaintiff's Exhibit #38 on page 9, I failed to designate those two documents in my designation of matter to be included in the record on appeal.

I need Defendants' Exhibits 2, 3, 4, and 5, page 133 of Vol. II of the Transcript, and Plaintiff's Exhibit #38 to be included in the record in order to prepare my final briefs. I have consulted in writing with opposing counsel but as of the close of business on Wednesday before Thanksgiving, had not resolved this matter. Since final briefs are due a week from Wednesday, I thought it best to bring this to the Court's attention.



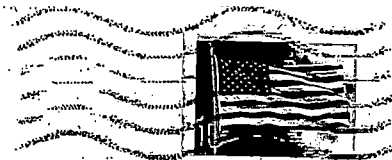
