**TRANSCRIPT**

The transcript for the unofficial and unscheduled hearing of 7 December 2018 has been ordered and received. The additional information related to the circumstances of that hearing

requested of Ms. Haffenden by letter of 20 July 2019 has not been received and the letter was returned.

A letter was sent to Ms. Kohn yesterday asking for the court reporter's name and contact information for the hearing that was scheduled before Judge Price but which Judge Murphy appeared at in August. Clearly I have not sent a letter to that court reporter asking for the transcript given I do not know that court reporters name and it is not listed on any of Judge Murphy's orders. Given Judge Murphy's legal jeopardy related to her conduct in case 2019-CP-10-00067 and 2018-CP-10-03315, compounded with her complete unwillingness to respond to any inquiries made of her, clearly asking Judge Murphy for the court reporter name and contact information is not a viable solution.

**PLACE APPEAL ON HOLD GIVEN THE SC COURT OF APPEALS AND STATE OF SOUTH CAROLINA'S CONFLICTS OF INTEREST**


Given the appeal of last week of case 2019-CP-10-00067, which obviously now connects improper actions and misconduct of most, if not all, of the attorneys and judges in this case(s) to cases 2014-CP-10-05407, 2017-CP-10-04031, 2018-00056, 2018-00174, etc., and the fact that knowing and willful misconduct in this case has improperly affected my rights, the conduct in all of these cases are now appropriately the venue of the United States Federal Judicial System. Given the misconduct in the above cited four cases, in particular beginning 23 March 2016 and continuing into 2019, the SC Court of Appeals and its judges have an obvious conflict of interest in this case as well as the recently appealed case of 2019-CP-10-00067.

WHEREFORE, Appellant Alan Nix respectfully requests this Court:

1. Grant and extension to order the remaining transcripts in this case.
