Inmate Johnson:

I have reviewed your grievance. Nurse P. Derrick, Nursing Supervisor, was contacted. She stated in accordance to SCDC Policy HS-18.17, Medical Copayment, established co-payment fees will be applicable to all inmates incarcerated in any SCDC facility regardless of his/her indigent status. Inmates who initiate visits to medical to include routine and emergency care, medications, and consultation services are considered by the Agency to have given implied consent for the assessment of the co-payment fee. When a medical entry is made into the automated system, the entry will automatically assess a medical co-payment charge for the inmate based upon the code entered. SCDC charges non-work release inmates \$5.00 per medical encounter and \$5.00 per filled prescription.

RESPONSIBLE OFFICIAL'S DECISION AND REASON:

Your grievance has been reviewed. In your allege South Carolina Department of Corrections is violating "South Carolina's State Constitution Art. XII Sec 2" by not providing "free medical care". You are requesting "full reimbursement of all monies taken from you since 2007 until now". Pursuant to Health Services policy HS-18.17 Medical CO-Payment, "SCDC is authorized to charge inmates a co-payment fee for any routine or emergency medical care, medications, and consultation service initiated or requested by the inmate. SCDC recognizes that the establishment of a co-payment system does not diminish its responsibility to provide inmates the opportunity to access necessary health care services regardless of their inability to pay. The Director of Health Services will be responsible for recommending a co-payment fee to the Agency Director that conforms with average national trends. The Agency Director will have final approval of the co-payment fee to be established for designated medical care and consultation services. The Agency Director reserves the right to adjust the established co-payment fee at any time to conform with changes in national trends, or in state or federal statutes or legislation, or other applicable requirements. Changes to the established co-payment fee will be posted at least 30 days prior to the effective date.

Therefore, your grievance is denied.

You may appeal this decision under the Administrative Procedures Act to the Administrative Law Court. In order to appeal, you must fill out the attached Notice of Appeal Form and submit it as instructed on the form within 30 days of receipt.

Statement of the Issues on Appeal

1. Whether SCDC's policy HS-18.17 authorizing charges to inmates account for co-payment of meds, medical health care violate State law?

2. Whether the Appellant is entitled to receive free medical health care under the SC Provision 37.16 authorized under Part 1(b) of the 2005-06 Appropriation Act?

Statement of the Case

On Tuesday February 26th 2019, the Appellant wrote an request to staff member, form 19-11, for an response.

On Thursday Feb. 28th 2019, the Appellant received an response from Nurse P. Derrick. Appellant, proceeded with step 1 grievance procedure on the same date.

On March 14th 2019, Appellant, received the Warden's response. Appellant, disagreed with the Warden's response, and then proceeded with step 2 on the same date received.

On April 15th 2019, the Appellant, received a response from the responsible official Mr. Wayne C. McCabe. On May 6th 2019, the Appellant filed his Notice of Appeal, after exhausting his grievance process.

Argument

1. Appellant argues that SCDC's policy HS-18.17 does violate the State's Constitution Article #1 Chapter #13 Section 24-13-80 (B)(2), which states that all depraived cost paid by a municipality or county for medical services for an inmate which have been requested by the inmate. This item does not apply to medical costs incurred as a result of injuries sustained by an inmate or other medically necessary treatment for which that inmate is determined not to be responsible.
2. Appellant, further argues that he is entitled to an full reimbursement of all monies paid to medical for services rendered since 2007. Appellant has been made aware that all medical care or health care debts incurred are deemed to be free medical and free health care under the S.C. Provision 37.16 authorized under Part 1(b) of the 2005-06 S.C. Appropriation Act.

Conclusion

Wherefore, Nathaniel Johnson Jr. # 211574, the Appellant prays that this Honorable Court, grants relief sought by ordering the Agency to reimburse all monies paid for medical services, as justice is so required, as a matter of law.





Disciplinary and Classification Review appeals must be submitted within five (5) working days of the hearing/review. Do not write in the space provided for the Warden's response.
5. If you are not satisfied with the Warden's decision, you may appeal to the appropriate responsible official within five (5) days of your receipt of the Warden's decision, by placing your Step 2 appeal form in the Grievance Box at your institution.

You are requesting "full reimbursement of all monies taken from you since 2007 until now". Pursuant to Health Services policy HS-18.17 Medical CO-Payment, "SCDC is authorized to charge inmates a co-payment fee for any routine or emergency medical care, medications, and consultation service initiated or requested by the inmate. SCDC recognizes that the establishment of a co-payment system does not diminish its responsibility to provide inmates the opportunity to access necessary health care services regardless of their inability to pay. The Director of Health Services will be responsible for recommending a co-payment fee to the Agency Director that conforms with average national trends. The Agency Director will have final approval of the co-payment fee to be established for designated medical care and consultation services. The Agency Director reserves the right to adjust the established co-payment fee at any time to conform with changes in national trends, or in state or federal statutes or legislation, or other applicable requirements. Changes to the established co-payment fee will be posted at least 30 days prior to the effective date.

Therefore, your grievance is denied.

STATEMENT OF THE CASE

This matter is before the Administrative Law Court (“ALC” or “Court”) pursuant to the appeal of Nathaniel Johnson (“Appellant”), an inmate incarcerated with the South Carolina Department of Corrections (“SCDC” or “Department”). Appellant is appealing SCDC’s final agency decision of April 15, 2019, that denied Appellant’s Step 2 grievance.

On February 28, 2019, Appellant filed a Step 1 grievance claiming that SCDC’s Medical Copayment policy is unlawful. On March 13, 2019, SCDC denied the Step 1 grievance. Thereafter, on March 14, 2019, Appellant filed a Step 2 grievance on the same issue. The grievance was investigated and subsequently denied on April 15, 2019. This appeal followed.

STANDARD OF REVIEW

The ALC’s jurisdiction to hear this matter is derived entirely from the decision of the South Carolina Supreme Court in *Al-Shabazz v. State*, 338 S.C. 354, 527 S.E.2d 742 (2000). When reviewing SCDC’s decisions in inmate grievance matters, the ALC sits in an appellate capacity. *Id.* at 377, 527 S.E.2d at 754. Subsequently, the Supreme Court clarified the ALC’s appellate jurisdiction over inmate appeals in *Sullivan v. S.C. Dep’t of Corr.*, 355 S.C. 437, 586 S.E.2d 124 (2003). In affirming, as modified, the ALC’s *en banc* decision of *McNeil v. S.C. Dep’t of Corr.*, 02-ALJ-04-00336-AP (September 5, 2001), the supreme court held the ALC’s

jurisdiction was limited to (1) cases in which an inmate contends prison officials have erroneously calculated his sentence, sentence-related credits, or custody status; (2) cases in which SCDC has taken an inmate's *state-created* liberty interest in major disciplinary hearings; and (3) cases in which an inmate's confinement implicates a *state-created* liberty interest. See *Sullivan*, 355 S.C. at 443, 586 S.E.2d at 127 (emphasis added).

Moreover, regarding categories (2) and (3), *supra*, the South Carolina Supreme Court has consistently emphasized that the liberty or property interest implicated must be one that is *state created*. See *Wicker v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 360 S.C. 421, 602 S.E.2d 56 (2004) (emphasizing that the ALC's jurisdiction extends only to those cases involving the denial of "state created liberty interests" and that the Court's holding [*i.e.*, in *Wicker*] "is not to be viewed as expanding the jurisdiction of the [ALC] in any other circumstance."); *Slezak v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 361 S.C. 327, 605 S.E.2d 506 (2004) (holding that the ALC "may summarily dismiss those appeals that do not implicate an inmate's *state created* liberty or property interest") (emphasis added).

SCDC interprets *Slezak* as encouraging, for the sake of judicial economy, the ALC to summarily dismiss inmate cases that do not involve a state-created liberty or property interest. Recently, the South Carolina Court of Appeals has interpreted *Slezak* to mean that where a state-created liberty interest is not implicated in a prisoner appeal, a judge of the ALC "should" dismiss the appeal. *Skipper v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 370 S.C. 267, 633 S.E.2d 910 (Ct. App. 2006).

Furthermore, a reviewing court will not disturb findings of an administrative agency if its findings are supported by substantial evidence on record as a whole. *Pearson v. JPS Converter & Industry Corp.*, 327 S.C. 393, 489 S.E.2d 219 (Ct. App. 1997). "Substantial evidence" is evidence which, considering record as a whole, would allow a reasonable mind to

reach the conclusion reached by the administrative agency. *Hendley v. S.C. State Budget & Control Bd.*, 325 S.C. 413, 481 S.E.2d 159 (Ct. App. 1996). The possibility of drawing two inconsistent conclusions from the evidence does not prevent an administrative agency's finding from being supported by substantial evidence. *Grant v. S.C. Coastal Council*, 319 S.C. 348, 461 S.E.2d 388 (1995). Administrative agencies are afforded wide latitude in making decisions, as shown in the deferential standard of appellate review. *Heater of Seabrook, Inc. v. Public Svc. Comm'n of S.C.*, 332 S.C. 20, 503 S.E.2d 739 (1998).

ARGUMENTS

I. THE COURT SHOULD DISMISS THIS APPEAL BECAUSE NO STATE CREATED LIBERTY OR PROPERTY INTEREST IS IMPLICATED IN THIS APPEAL

In order for the ALC to properly hear cases involving an inmate's liberty or property interest, the South Carolina Supreme Court has consistently emphasized that the liberty or property interest implicated must be one that is *state created*. See *Wicker v. S.C. Dep't of Corr.*, 360 S.C. 421, 602 S.E.2d 56 (2004) (emphasis added). While the Court in *Wicker* did find that there was a state created interest in wages for working, the Court also states that this was a "very limited circumstance" and the "holding [] is extremely limited and is not to be viewed as expanding the jurisdiction of the ALJ in any other circumstances". *Id.* at 424, n.1. Appellant does not allege that the deductions from his account are from working wages, nor does he allege that the Department is preventing him from earning wages.

The *Wicker* court stated that in addition to cases that involve inmate discipline and erroneous sentence calculation, a state-created interest can arise in instances that invoke procedural due process under the Fourteenth Amendment. *Id.* at 424, 602 S.E.2d at 58 (citing *Al-Shabazz v. State*, 338 S.C. 354, 369, 527 S.E.2d 742, 750 (1999) ("procedural due process is guaranteed when an inmate is deprived of an interest encompassed by the Fourteenth

Amendment's protection of liberty and property.”). An individual claiming a protected property interest under the Fourteenth Amendment must have a “legitimate claim of entitlement to it”. *Kentucky Dep't of Corr. v. Thompson*, 490 U.S. 454, 460 (1989). Procedural due process is not invoked in the present case. Courts have held that debits for costs such as medical copayments are not deprivations under the Fourteenth Amendment because an inmate is being provided a service or good in exchange for the funds debited. *Browder v. Ankrom*, 2005 WL 1026045, at *5 (W.D. Ky. Apr. 25, 2005). The U.S. Sixth Circuit Court of Appeals held that although inmates have a protected property interest in their money, inmates are not deprived when deductions are made for value received. *Bailey v. Carter*, 15 F. App'x 245, 251 (6th Cir. 2001) (citing *Jensen v. Klecker*, 648 F.2d 1179, 1183 (8th Cir.1981) (per curiam)).

Similarly, the U.S. District Court for the District of South Carolina held that charges for medical copayments are not deprivations under the Fourteenth Amendment. *Sturkey v. Ozmint*, 2009 U.S. Dist. LEXIS 18786, *6, 2009 WL 649569 (D.S.C. March 10, 2009) (holding that “debts such as those made for filing fees, medical services, and expenses are not ‘deprivations’ because the inmate has been provided with a service or good in exchange for the money debited.”). Accordingly, deductions for medical copayments are not deprivations under the Fourteenth Amendment.

Further, a claim arising from the deprivation of property without due process is actionable under 42 U.S.C. § 1983.¹ *Browder* at *5 (citing *Lynch v. Household Finance*, 405 U.S. 538 (1972)). Additionally, Appellant has the option of filing an action for conversion in the state circuit court. See *Moseley v. Oswald*, 376 S.C. 251, 656 S.E.2d 380, 382 (2008) (indicating that South Carolina courts define conversion as “the unauthorized assumption in the

¹ The U.S. Fourth Circuit Court of Appeals vacated summary judgement for defendants in a § 1983 action regarding an inmate's E.H. Cooper account being deducted for medical expenses resulting from an attack by five inmates. *Burks v. Pate*, 119 F. App'x 447 (4th Cir. 2005).

exercise of the right of ownership over goods or personal chattels belonging to another to the exclusion of the owner's rights"); *Hawkins v. City of Greenville*, 358 S.C. 280, 594 S.E.2d 557, 566 (Ct. App. 2004) (conversion is a wrongful act that may arise by the illegal use or misuse, or by a wrongful taking or detention, of another's personal property). Thus, private rights of action are available to Appellant. If Appellant feels he was deprived of property without due process, he may file a conversion action in state court or a § 1983 action in Federal District Court. However, to the extent that the ALC wishes to exert jurisdiction in this case, deductions for medical copayments are not deprivations under the Fourteenth Amendment. Therefore, deductions from Appellant's account for medical copayments does not invoke a state-created property or liberty interest and the Court should dismiss this case.

II. THE COURT SHOULD AFFIRM SCDC'S FINAL AGENCY DECISION

To the extent the Court declines to dismiss this case for the above reasons, SCDC respectfully requests that the Court affirm its final agency decision denying Appellant's Step 2 grievance. In this case, Appellant complains that SCDC's debiting of his account for copayments made to medical violates South Carolina Code section 24-13-80(B)(2) because he is entitled to free medical care. Subsection (B)(2) of the statute allows a "reasonable deduction" to "defray the costs paid by a municipality or county for medical services for an inmate, which have been requested by the inmate, if the deduction does not exceed five dollars for each occurrence of treatment received by the inmate." S.C. Code Ann. § 24-13-80 (B)(2). Subsection (B)(2) also states that "[t]his item does not apply to medical costs incurred as a result of injuries sustained by an inmate or other medically necessary treatment for which an inmate is determined not to be responsible." *Subsection (B)(2) does not apply to the medical copayments debited from Appellant's account by SCDC, a state agency, since it only applies to

“the costs paid by a municipality or county.” Therefore, Appellant’s argument, which is based upon the language in subsection (B)(2), is misplaced.

Appellant also argues that the 2005-2006 South Carolina Appropriations Act, Proviso 37.16, entitles him to free healthcare. The language contained in the proviso has been included in the South Carolina Appropriations Act since the 2003-2004 fiscal year and is now in Proviso 65.8. The medical payments at issue in this case are authorized by the South Carolina Appropriations Act, Proviso 65.8, which states as follows:

The Department of Corrections shall be authorized to charge inmates a nominal fee for any medical treatment or consultation provided at the request of or initiated by the inmate. A nominal co-pay shall be charged for prescribed medications. Inmates shall not be charged for psychological or mental health visits.

H. B. 3720, GENERAL APPROPRIATIONS BILL, FISCAL YEAR ~~2018-2019~~. A plain reading of the Proviso clearly authorizes the Department to charge inmates a nominal fee for any requested medical treatment or consultation.

SCDC Policy HS-18.17, section 3.2, states that “[c]o-payment fees will be charged in any instance in which the inmate initiates or requests any routine or emergency medical care or consultation, to include, ^{*}but not be limited to sick call requests.” Section 2.2 provides that “Inmates **should not be** denied or refused access to health care services because s/he has insufficient funds to pay the medical co-payment fee.” ^{*}This policy is in keeping with Proviso 65.8 and does not violate state law. Accordingly, Appellant’s argument that he should be reimbursed for all medical expenses is without merit.

For the reasons discussed above, this Court should affirm SCDC’s final agency decision.

CONCLUSION

The Court should dismiss this appeal because this case does not invoke a state created property or liberty interest. However, to the extent the Court declines to dismiss this appeal,

the Court should affirm the Departments' decision.

Standard of Review

The (ALC) Administrative Law Court sits in an appellate capacity under the (APA) Ill. Administrative Procedure Act, rather than as an independent finder of fact. The standard used by appellate bodies to review agency decisions is provided by Ill. Code

Ann § 1-23-600(5) Supp 2016 Section § 1-23-380(5) reads:

The court may not substitute its judgment for the judgment of the agency as to the weight of the evidence on question of fact. The court may affirm the decision of the agency or remand the case for further proceedings. The court may reverse or modify the decision if the substantial rights of the Appellant have been prejudiced because the administrative findings, interference, conclusions, or decisions are:

- (a) in violation of constitutional or statutory provisions;
- (b) in excess of the statutory authority of the agency;
- (c) made upon unlawful procedure;
- (d) affected by other errors of law;
- (e) clearly erroneous in view of the reliable, probative and substantial evidence on the whole record;
- (f) arbitrary or capricious or characterized by abuse of discretion

Argument

1. Appellant asserts that the State's agency (SEDC) has created policies and procedures that violated procedural and substantive due process rights of the Appellant. Thus, depriving him of his protected liberty and property interest in violation of the Fifth and Fourteenth Amendment Sec 1.
2. The Appellant's E.H. Cooper trust account has been debited in deduction of the amount of \$200.00 per year since 2007, for medical co-pay and prescription meds. The Fourteenth Amendment Section 1 reads:

No State shall make or enforce any law which shall abridge the privileges or immunities of citizens of the United States, nor shall any State deprive any person of life, liberty, or property without due process of law, nor deny to any person within its jurisdiction the equal protection of the laws.

The responsible official admitted in step 2 Wayne C. McCabe, that this matter exceeds the jurisdiction of SEDC's authority. Changes will be posted at least 30 days prior to its effective date.

3. The Fifth and Fourteenth Amendment prohibits the government from taking or depriving an inmate of life, liberty, or property without due process of law.

A violation of procedural or substantive due process requires 1). that the state has interfered with the inmate's protected liberty or property interest; and 2). that procedural safeguards were constitutionally insufficient to protect against unjustified deprivations or the taking of one's protected liberty or property interest, that were state created interest through unlawful policies and procedures.

4. The State's agency (SCDC) created regulations and policies that deprive the Appellant of his liberty and protected property interest. The Appropriation Act B0150 65.8 and the agency (SCDC)'s policy HS-18.17 violates the Ex Post Facto Clause of the SC. Constitution Art 1 Sec 7 and the U. S. Constitution Art. 1 Secs 9 & 10 cl 3, which provide that neither Congress nor any state shall pass an ex post facto law.

5. See *State v. Huiett, 302 S.C. 169, 394 S.E.2d. 486 (S.C. 1990), in order for the ex post facto clause to be applicable the statute or provision in question must be criminal or penal in purpose and nature.
6. Also, See *Weaver v. Graham, 450 U.S. 24, 101 S.Ct. 960, 67 L.Ed.2d. 17 (1981), a law which imposes additional punishment to that prescribed at the time the offense was committed is prohibited under the Ex Post Facto Clauses of the S.C. Constitution and the U.S. Constitution Art 1 Secs 9 & 10 cl 3.

Therefore, the new Article 65.8 of the General Appropriation Act 2018-19, was not in effect at the time of the Appellant's previous offense, and does not apply.

Conclusion

The Court should based its opinion on the standard of review that such procedural change created a state policy or procedure that infringed on the substantial rights of the Appellant and his Amended Motion for an Summary Judgment should be granted as a matter of law.

Reimbursement for Medical Healthcare Payments

Appellant contends that S.C. Provision 37.16 authorized under Part 1(b) of the 2005-06 Appropriation Act entitles inmates to free medical healthcare; therefore, he is seeking a full reimbursement of all medical healthcare payments he made since 2007. In its Respondent’s Brief, the Department contends the ALC has no jurisdiction over this issue. The Court agrees.

The ALC has subject matter jurisdiction when the Department disciplines an inmate and imposes a punishment that deprives the inmate of a constitutionally protected liberty or property interest. *Al-Shabazz v. State*, 338 S.C. 354, 369, 527 S.E.2d 742, 750 (2000). *Slezak v. South Carolina Department of Corrections* provided further clarification that this Court has jurisdiction of all inmate grievance appeals that have been properly filed. 361 S.C. 327, 605 S.E.2d 506 (2004). However, when the grievance appeal does not implicate a state-created liberty or property interest, the ALC may summarily dismiss the appeal at its discretion. *Howard v. South Carolina Department of Corrections*, 399 S.C. 618, 733 S.E.2d 211 (2012).


For the purpose of establishing jurisdiction, a state-created liberty or property interest exists when (1) an inmate is disciplined and punishment is imposed, or (2) when an inmate alleges prison officials have erroneously calculated his sentence, sentence-related credits, or custody status. *Sullivan v. S.C. Dep’t of Corr.*, 355 S.C. 437, 441, 586 S.E.2d 124, 126 (2003). Additionally, this Court has jurisdiction when an inmate contests the Department’s decision to permanently deny the inmate’s parole eligibility. *Id.* Finally, under certain circumstances, an inmate may have a state-created liberty interest in “freedom from restraint which, while not exceeding the sentence in such an unexpected manner as to give rise to protection by the Due Process Clause of its own force . . . nonetheless imposes atypical and significant hardship on the inmate in relation to the ordinary incidents of prison life.” *Sandin v. Conner*, 515 U.S. 472, 483-84 (1995); *see Sullivan*, 355 S.C. at 443, 586 S.E.2d at 127 (applying *Sandin* to resolve a condition of confinement claim).

In this appeal, Appellant’s issue does not arise from punishment administered for a disciplinary conviction, nor does it relate to Appellant’s sentence, sentence-related credits, or custody. Furthermore, this appeal does not involve an “atypical” condition of restraint. Accordingly, Appellant has not alleged deprivation of a state-created liberty or property interest

in this matter. Therefore, the Court finds *Howard* to be controlling, and the case must be dismissed for lack of jurisdiction.

ORDER

Based upon the foregoing, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that this appeal is DISMISSED. AND IT IS SO ORDERED.³

The Free South Carolina Movement strongly supports the Second Chance Initiative

On Jan 8, 2019, the South Carolina legislature will have an opportunity to pass a set of laws which will positively affect the mass incarceration problem. Bills H 3322 and S 155 are designed to accomplish very similar goals in South Carolina to those envisioned by the U.S. Congress for federal prisoners in the recently enacted First Step Act (HR 5882).

Briefly, South Carolina's H 3322 provides a mechanism to determine the likelihood of a prisoner re-offending if the prisoner were released from the South Carolina Department of Corrections, providing an opportunity for prisoners to advance in custody upon completing a number of rehabilitative programs while disciplinary free for a time and clearly provides an opportunity for a prisoner under

a sentence of Life Without Parole (LWOP) to petition the circuit court of conviction and the county solicitor for a sentence modification after a service of 15 years and after the prisoner has completed a rehabilitation program. Education program or (has) shown exemplary conduct consistently during that 15 year period.

S 155 provides a host of benefits for South Carolina prisoners currently serving no parole offense sentences at a rate of 85 percent who are working hard to change themselves by completing offered programs and maintaining a clean disciplinary record to complete their incarceration time under community supervision under a reduced rate of 65 percent.

H 3322 and S 155 both will be a much needed change to help well meaning and productive prisoners in South Carolina who suffer behind the actions of other prisoners who are not seeking to better

themselves. authorities in South Carolina have approved blanket punishments of the prisoners as a whole out of exaggerated fears grounded in clear incompetence of how to evaluate the prisoners individually in compliance with established policies and procedures and enactment of H 3322 and S 155 during the upcoming 2019-2020 legislative session will more than likely provide an incentive and basis for improvement in prisoner behavior as a whole.

Thus, in solidarity, we ask for all available support in convincing the South Carolina Legislature to enact H 3322 and S 155 into law.
