MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

Counsel for Tarrance L. Jordan respectfully requests an extension of thirty (30) days in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a second request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be served and filed with the Court today.
2. Counsel for Tarrance L. Jordan respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.

Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of John Hicks v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 28, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jarret Graddick v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 14, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Derrell Green v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 7, 2019.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office has been informed of this request.




