

ORDER

Appellant has filed a "Request to Petition for Supersedeas/Stay with the Full Appellate Court and Request to Stay All Time Limit[s] to the appeal filing process." This court construes Appellant's motion as a petition for supersedeas under Rule 241(d)(2) of the South Carolina Rules of Appellate Procedure. After careful consideration, the petition is denied.

Appellant also seeks clarification of this court's November 13, 2019 order and its letter of the same day, which he argues conflict. We clarify that this court accepted and considered Appellant's reply on November 13, 2019, before issuing its order adhering to its denial of Appellant's Petition for Supersedeas/Stay, and the clerk's office's letter was sent in error.

Finally, Appellant requests this court hold his appeal in abeyance and remand the case for the circuit court to consider two 2016 motions. The request is denied. This court will consider the merits of the case once final briefing is complete.
