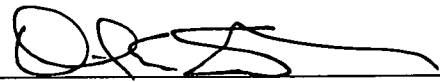

ORDER

Petitioner has filed a notice of appeal seeking review of the decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals in Appellate Case Number 2019-00296. Since a decision of the Court of Appeals is reviewed by serving and filing a petition for a writ of certiorari under Rule 242 of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules (SCACR), this notice of appeal has been construed as a petition for a writ of certiorari.

This petition for a writ of certiorari fails to have the content required by Rule 242(d), SCACR. Further, petitioner has failed to serve and file an appendix having the content specified by Rule 224(e), SCACR. Finally, petitioner has failed to pay the filing fee required by Rule 224(c), SCACR, or to seek a waiver of that fee. Accordingly, the petition for a writ of certiorari is dismissed.
