Ms. Harris.

Your name is listed as the court reporter on an order signed by Judge Jefferson back in October in the above cited case. The date of the hearing was 26 September 2019 in Charleston County. You may remember the hearing based on an exchange I had with Judge Jefferson about a fraudulent order filed by her protégé Judge Scarborough back on 23 March 2016 in one of the related cases, 2014-CP-10-05407 to be specific.

Orders from this hearing have been appealed, consequently, I will need the transcript from this hearing.

Having said that, I want to make sure you are aware that this situation is, legally, quite precarious at this point. Judge Jefferson knowingly and willfully included statements of apparent fact in those orders which were simply, to put it politely, not true. Furthermore, given some of Judge Jefferson's knowingly and willfully untrue statements can easily be construed as aiding and abetting other judge's misconduct, which have already participated in aiding and abetting fraudulent conduct by attorneys and others in related cases, obviously this situation is highly sensitive.

Consequently, you will be subpoenaed for all other information in your possession related to this hearing in the not so distant future. Information such as audio recordings of the hearing, steno notes, email related to the hearing, etc. Please ensure all of this information is secured until you receive the subpoena. If Mr. Wilson asks for the information in your possession, please decline his request. It is currently anticipated the subpoena will be from a Federal court.

Obviously I have copied others on this letter as an attempt to be proactive and appropriate, but you should also be aware that other SC State agencies and Public Officials are also involved in these matters, including but not limited to the SC Court of Appeals. So, a motion to put the appeal on hold will be submitted within the next few days while the criminal matters related to the Public Official

misconduct, fraud, etc. are finally properly addressed. Perhaps the easiest way to provide a condensed version of this story is the old saying, "the cover up is always worse than the crime".

Please let me know the cost of the transcript and if you or the State of South Carolina have any price reductions available for indigent people. (btw., I wasn't indigent until I and my family have had to endure more than six years of attorney and Public Official fraud and corruption.)

Thank you for your assistance and please let me know at your earliest convenience, of course with copy to the three people copied below.

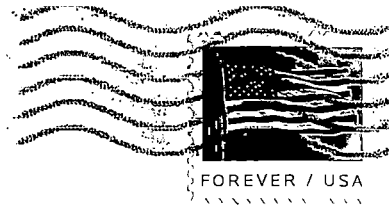
