

ORDER

The State asks this Court to strike Petitioner's Questions 6-22 in the revised petition for a writ of certiorari for failing to comply with Rule 243(e)(3), SCACR, and this Court's order denying Petitioner's motion to exceed the twenty-five-page limit. Petitioner's reply to the motion asks this Court to reconsider its decision to limit the certiorari petition in this matter to twenty-five total pages.

The motion to strike is granted, and the paragraph on page seven of the revised petition for a writ of certiorari referencing Questions 6-22 is hereby stricken.

We deny Petitioner's request to reconsider the denial of his motion to exceed the twenty-five-page limit of Rule 243(e)(3). Petitioner shall, within ten (10) days of the date of this order, file a revised petition for a writ of certiorari that complies with Rule 243(e)(3).
