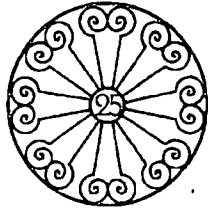

NOW COMES Petitioner, Winsor Custom Homes, LLC, by and through its undersigned counsel, on the grounds stated below, and, pursuant to Rule 263(b), SCACR, as well as the Court's order of July 16, 2014, regarding Extensions in Cases Seeking a Petition for a Writ of Certiorari to Review a Decision of the South Carolina Court of Appeals, hereby moves for an extension of ten (10) days' time to petition this Court for a writ of certiorari to review the Court of Appeals' decision in this matter.

1. The Court of Appeals denied rehearing on November 15, 2019, making the deadline to file/serve a petition for a writ of certiorari Monday, December 16, 2019, pursuant to Rule 242(c), SCACR.¹


2. Due to other time commitments, both work- and non-work-related, the undersigned would greatly appreciate ten (10) additional days, beyond December 16, 2019, to prepare Petitioner's forthcoming petition for a writ of certiorari and humbly submits good cause exists to allow this dispensation: it being in furtherance of the interests of justice, not unduly prejudicial to Respondent, and consistent with the terms of the Court's aforementioned order of July 16, 2014.

WHEREFORE, Petitioner respectfully requests that this Honorable Court allow it ten (10) days beyond Monday, December 16, 2019, to file/serve its petition

for a writ of certiorari, i.e., to extend the deadline through Friday, December 27, 2019.² Additionally, Petitioner requests that the Court hold the present deadline in abeyance until it acts on this motion.
