MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME  
IN WHICH TO FILE THE PETITION FOR WRIT OF  
CERTIORARI AND APPENDIX

Counsel for Leroy Glover, Jr. respectfully requests a **final thirty (30) day extension, until January 13, 2020**, in which to file the petition for writ of certiorari and appendix in this case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a third request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The petition for writ of certiorari and appendix are due to be filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel two previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Leroy Glover, Jr. respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the number of extensions

previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage her caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.


3. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jerry Dean Heard v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on December 4, 2019. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. Keshawn Melvin Rice with the Court of Appeals on December 4, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Tyrone Joseph Whatley v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on November 7, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Timothy L. Frady v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on November 4, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Derek Maner v. The State of South Carolina with this Court on October 23, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State of South Carolina v. David Paul Merritt with the Court of Appeals on October 16, 2019.

4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.


5. Counsel for the Attorney General's office consents to this request as shown by signature below.


