ORDER

Respondent's motion to dismiss this appeal is granted. *See* Rule 203(b)(1), SCACR ("A notice of appeal shall be served on all respondents within thirty (30) days after receipt of written notice of entry of the order or judgment."); *Wells Fargo Bank, N.A. v. Fallon Properties S.C., LLC*, 422 S.C. 211, 219, 810 S.E.2d 856, 860 (2018) (holding an email sent from the court that provides written notice of entry of an order triggers the time for serving a notice of appeal for purposes of Rule 203(b)(1), SCACR); *In re South Carolina Elec. Filing Policies and Guidelines*, 415 S.C. 1, 10, 780 S.E.2d 600, 605 (2015) (providing an authorized e-filer has receipt of written notice of the filing of an order upon receipt of the emailed notice of electronic filing and any delay in accessing the e-filing system to review the order does not affect the time of receipt); Rule 263(b), SCACR ("The time prescribed by these Rules for performing any act except the time for serving the notice of appeal under Rules 203 and 243 may be extended . . ."); *Mears v. Mears*, 287 S.C. 168, 337 S.E.2d 206 (1985) (providing serving the notice of appeal is a jurisdictional requirement, and the appellate courts have no authority to extend the time in which the notice of intent to appeal must be served). The remittitur will be sent as provided in Rule 221, SCACR.
