Respondent, by and through the undersigned counsel, making its Motion to Relax Rule 243(g) and Request for Extension, would show unto this Court:

I.

Respondent's Return to Petition for Writ of Certiorari was due to be filed and served on November 11, 2019. However, the due date for this matter was inadvertently left off of the calendar for undersigned counsel. The Court inquired as to the status of the filing by email on Friday, December 13, 2019, bringing the matter to the undersigned's attention. 
