ORDER

The appeal in this case is pending before the South Carolina Court of Appeals.¹ The Court of Appeals denied petitioner's motion to proceed in forma pauperis, and petitioner has now filed a petition asking this Court to either grant him permission to proceed in forma pauperis, or to issue a writ of mandamus to compel the Court of Appeals to grant his motion to proceed in forma pauperis.

The petition is denied. Instead, if petitioner believes that the Court of Appeals committed error in denying the motion to proceed in forma pauperis, he should seek review in the manner specified by Rule 242 of the South Carolina Appellate
