MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

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

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Joseph Brown with the Court of Appeals on November 4, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of John Hicks v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 28, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jarret Graddick v. The State with the Supreme Court on October 14, 2019.


4. Counsel makes this request in good faith and not for purpose of delay.
