

ORDER

Appellant's motion for an extension of time is granted. If Appellant obtains counsel, counsel shall serve and file a notice of appearance within thirty days. Appellant's "motion to enter new information directly related and motion to award demand and judgment" is denied. *See* Rule 210, SCACR (providing the record on appeal shall not include any documents that were not presented to the lower court).

Respondents' motion to strike Appellant's record on appeal and second record on appeal is granted. Within thirty days, Appellant shall serve and file an amended record on appeal, which includes all documents listed by the parties in their designations of matter and excludes any matter that was not presented to the master in equity. The amended record shall include an index, shall be numbered

consecutively beginning with the index, and shall be arranged in the order set forth in Rule 210(c) of the South Carolina Appellate Court Rules.
