in the following particulars:

DESCRIPTION OF OFFENSE: Murder / Murder

I further state that there is probable cause to believe that the defendant named above did commit the crime set forth and that probable cause is based on the following facts:

On or about the dates of May 14, 2017 through May 15, 2017, the defendant, Dale King, did with a malice aforethought did murder his wife and victim, Veronica King within a hotel room of the Atlantic Inn. The defendant provided an initial statement to law enforcement that he was unaware of the cause of death, reported no disputes between the 2 of them, and was unaware of the cause of an injury to her lips. The defendant would later recant this statement and advised of a verbal altercation and striking the victim across the face. An autopsy conducted by medical experts determined manner of death as homicide via strangulation. Security footage of the complex shows nobody entering/departing the hotel room during the approximate time of the homicide. Furthermore, there are no adjoining interior hotel-room doors. This violation occurred at 2249 Boundary Street, Unit 233, which is in the City Limits of Beaufort, SC. The affiant has others to prove the same.
