1. Front page of Appellant Initial Brief – dated the 5th day of December, 2019 – received by me by mail on December 6, 2019.
2. South Carolina Appellate Case Management System Case Information – shows Initial Brief – Appellant filed on 12/05/2019.
3. My letter to Clerk dated December 5, 2019, which indicates that no document was received by me by December 5, 2019 – filed with Court on 12/06/2019, as indicated on Case Management System.

In accordance with the Order filed on October 25, 2019, as modified by the cover letter dated October 25, 2019, copies of which are also enclosed, the appellant's initial brief and designation must be served and filed by December 2, 2019. This did not happen. Nothing was filed until three business days after this deadline.

Importantly, the final deadline (to December 2, 2019) was the second extension granted to Appellant following several other delays and extensions granted to Appellant related to his failure to timely order the trial transcript, which resulted in an Order dismissing the appeal, filed on April 24, 2019.

This appeal was filed on December 7, 2018. The initial documents due from Appellant were not filed until two days short of a full year after the appeal was filed. The trial transcript was received by Appellant on July 9, 2019. Who else is given more than 146 days (after receiving the transcript) to file an Initial Brief?




