MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION  
TO FILE THE INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT

Counsel for Tony Dequan Manago, respectfully requests a **fourth and final** thirty (30) day extension **until February 3, 2020**, in which to file the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the above-referenced case. This motion is made pursuant to the Order of the South Carolina Supreme Court dated March 18, 2009. This is a fourth request for an extension. In support of this request, counsel shows:

1. The initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in this case are due to be served and filed with the Court today. The Court has granted counsel three previous extensions.
2. Counsel for Tony Dequan Manago, respectfully submits that extraordinary circumstances exist which warrant the granting of an additional extension of time. Given the

number of extensions previously granted and the order in which counsel attempts to manage his caseload, counsel hopes that no further extension requests will be required.



Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Marion Bonds v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 25, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Touriarnold Spann v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 25, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Mary Ann German with the Court of Appeals on November 22, 2019. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Frederick Calvin Jones with the Court of Appeals on November 8, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of William Brockmeyer v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 6, 2019. Counsel filed the Anders brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of In the Matter of the Care and Treatment of Kenneth Wright with the Court of Appeals on November 4, 2019.




