

The Administrative Law Court admitted its inability to review the full scope of SCDPPPS decision making process. A process that does fall under S.C. 

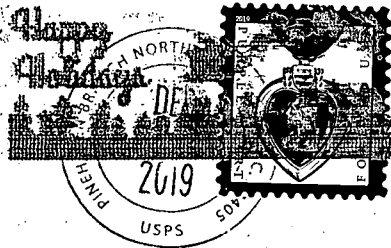
