

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Tyquin Jenkins with the Court of Appeals on December 2, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Quantae Priest v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 25, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Jeff Chestnut v. The State with the Supreme Court on November 12, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of The State v. Joseph Brown with the Court of Appeals on November 4, 2019.

3. As indicated by her consent below, counsel for the state does not oppose this request.


