The last documents I sent to you, **SC Court of Appeals** with Appellate Case No: 2017-001863, which deals with a Motion to Vacate Sentence I already served. I don't understand why you sent me the enclosed letter Date December 11, 2019. The recent and last documents I sent to you, were pertaining to 2 Motions I filed, in which Judge Verdin denied. In a letter she sent to me in response to a letter I sent to her or him, inquiring into the disposition of the two Motions I filed with the office of the clerk of Court, Greenville County Court at General Sessions; one of these Motions was for a New trial pursuant to a Brady Violation, - the other was a Motion to set aside the judgment of Supreme Court and restate the judgment of SC Court of appeal unpublished opinion 2011-UP-091 Due to grounds of fraud upon the court. Greenville, that I had filed such motion: It appears to be some  
sort of conspiracy, between the Schieffelin's office and Judge Verdin, not to  
properly schedule my motions on the General Sessions Court dockets, because  
they acknowledge they have merits. Please return my recent documents  
to me that I last sent to you. I even requested that you return them to me  
with your response.
