**PETITION FOR EXTENSION TO FILE
INITIAL BRIEF OF APPELLANT AND

Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Leslie Davis in the Court of Appeals on October 23, 2019. Counsel filed the initial brief of appellant and designation of matter in the case of State v. Therron Renard Richardson in the Court of Appeals on October 16, 2019. Counsel had an oral argument in the case of State v. Thomas Stephen Acker in the Court of Appeals on October 10, 2019. Counsel filed the petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Harold Lee Jones v. State in the Supreme Court on September 20, 2019. Counsel filed the Johnson petition for writ of certiorari and accompanying appendix in the case of Greg K. Isaac v. State in the Supreme Court on September 16, 2019.

3. This request is made in good faith, and not for purposes of delay.


4. As indicated by his consent below, counsel for the state graciously consents to or does not oppose this request.




