Appellant Travis Stewart Motions the Court for Leave of Court for Excusable Neglect for Appellant's Motion to File *In Pauperis* Appellant's Motion to Stay Respondent's *Writ of Ejectment*, Compel Respondent to return SCE&G utilities to Appellant, add Beverley D. Wilson as Co-Appellant to Complaint, and Abate lease late fees and interest due to extreme extenuating circumstances and any future motions and pleadings in this action due to extremely dire financial circumstances. Appellant Travis Stewart is a graduate student in Biomedical Engineering at the University of South Carolina, and is unemployed due to recovering from an acute exacerbation of spectral Post Traumatic Stress Disorder. Appellant's only source of income is his overage from financial aid as a graduate student.

Appellant asserts that repeated appeals to succeeding appellate courts from the original lower court in this action have exhausted Appellant's funds. Appellant has \$2 in funds at this time and has limit access to any other funding, e.g. loans, due to Appellant's lack of employment. Appellant's family is unable to assist Appellant financially due to their own financially extremely strained or financially demised circumstances.

Appellant Prays the Court Grants Appellant's Motion to File *In Pauperis* this Motion for Leave of Court for Excusable Neglect to submit Appellant's Motion and Memorandum to Stay Respondent's *Writ of Ejectment*, Compel Respondent to Return SCE&G Utilities to Appellant, Add Beverley D. Wilson as Co-Appellant to this Complaint, Abate lease late fees and interest, and submit the accompanying documents listed herein to the Court in response to the December 2, 2019 Order of this Court and future Motions and Pleadings in this action.

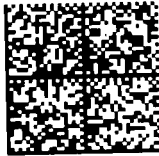

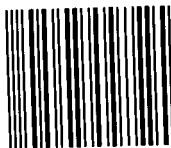
