MOTION TO WITHDRAW AS COUNSEL

THIS MATTER comes before the Court by way of an appeal from a Post-Conviction Relief Order. On December 16, 2019, undersigned counsel was offered, and he accepted, a position in the Appellate Division of the Federal Public Defender's Office. Undersigned counsel's employment will begin on February 3, 2020. Undersigned counsel cannot represent clients in a private capacity when he is employed with the Federal Public Defender's Office.

Undersigned counsel sent a letter to the Appellant on December 24, 2019, notifying him of undersigned counsel's change in employment and to advise the Appellant of his options moving forward with his appeal. Undersigned counsel subsequently met with the Appellant at his

institution, Broad River Correctional Institution, on January 9, 2020, to further discuss these issues. At that time, the Appellant indicated that he intended to request appointed counsel represent him on this appeal. The Appellant, however, had not completed the affidavit of indigency that undersigned counsel provided to the Appellant in his letter sent to the Appellant on December 24, 2019. The Appellant did not oppose undersigned counsel's request to be relieved when undersigned counsel met with him.

Given all of the above, undersigned counsel respectfully requests that this Court permit him to withdraw as counsel in this appeal pursuant to Rule 264(b), SCACR. Undersigned counsel has attempted to consult with opposing counsel regarding this request, but has not received a response as of the filing of this motion. Furthermore, undersigned counsel is serving a copy of this motion on the Appellant as well as providing a copy of this motion to Appellate Defense.
