## ORDER

---

First, Appellant's motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* is granted.

Second, Appellant's motion to supplement the record is premature. Appellant shall serve and file a designation of matter to include in the record along with Appellant's initial brief. The designation of matter shall only include exhibits and matters that were actually presented to the lower court. *See* Rule 210(c), SCACR ("The Record shall not . . . include matter which was not presented to the lower court or tribunal.").

Third, Appellant's motion for the appointment of counsel is denied. *See Ex parte Dibble*, 279 S.C. 592, 310 S.E.2d 440 (1983) (providing there is no right to appointed counsel in civil matters).
